### **REVIEW OF FINANCIAL RESULTS**

Results for the first 6 months ended 31 December 2008

### **Income and Expenses Review**

The Group's revenue increased by 38.0% or S\$42.73 million to S\$155.13 million in the first 6 months ended 31 December 2008 (1HFY2009) compared to S\$112.41 million for the same period last year (1HFY2008).

Despite the higher revenue, the Group's gross profit for 1HFY2009 decreased by 6.0% as compared to 1HFY2008. This was due to the sharp fall in metal prices at the end of 2008. Metal prices peaked in September 2008 before suffering drastic drop resulting from the global credit crisis.

The Group registered a loss after tax of S\$9.86 million for the first half FY2009 as compared to a net profit after tax of S\$13.16 million for the corresponding period in the preceding financial year. The bulk of the loss arose from the write down in fair value of our Indonesia's quoted shares investment as well as impairment loss in inventories.

With the deteriorating economic conditions and prolonged decline in fair value below its cost of investment in the current volatile equity market condition, the Group reversed our previous fair value reserve from the balance sheet to the profit and loss statement and further provided impairment loss in this Indonesia's quoted shares to reflect its current value.

Other operating income decreased due to foreign exchange loss of S\$2.48 million and lower extraordinary items such as gain on disposal of fixed assets in 1HFY2009 compared to the same period in FY2008.

### **Balance Sheet Review**

The Group's inventories decreased by 19.8% to S\$56.49 million from S\$70.48 million in 1HFY2009 as compared to last financial year ended 30 June 2008. With the market downturn and slide in metal prices, the Management resolved to improve liquidity by reducing inventories.

Shareholders equity was S\$50.99 million as at 31 December 2008, a decrease of S\$17.32 million from S\$68.31 million as at 30 June 2008. This was mainly a result of loss incurred for impairments and dividend paid out during the period.

### **Cash Flow Statement Review**

Net cash generated from operating activities in 1H FY2009 was S\$16.47 million compared to the net cash used in operations of S\$4.03 millions in 1H FY2008. This was due mainly to a decrease in inventories held and a reduction of trade and other receivables.

Net cash used in financing activities was S\$19.34 million, including repayment of bills payable and dividend paid in November 2008. Total borrowing reduced by 20.0% to S\$43.24 million as at 31 December 2008 compared to S\$54.05 million as at 30 June 2008.

Challenging market conditions following the double blow from the global economic economic crisis and credit crunch have led many to adopt a conservative, wait-and-see attitude. Demand for metals is still relatively slow while metal prices are beginning to show signs of stabilising after the precipitous drop in the last quarter of 2008.

Going forward, challenging conditions in metal markets are expected to persist in the short term as prices may not recover. The Management will continue to watch the market vigilantly and respond speedily to market conditions and strive to improve our performance.
