REVIEW OF FINANCIAL RESULTS

Review for the three months ended 31 March 2009

The Group's revenue decreased by 14.5% or \$13.3 million to \$78.9 million for the three months ended 31 March 2009 compared to the corresponding period in FY2008. The lower revenue was primarily due to lower demand and lower market prices for metals and steel in the first three months of 2009 compared to the same period in 2008. As a result, gross profit decline 92.6% to \$0.7 million.

Other operating income rose 131.4% to \$6.6 million, boosted by the sale of industrial property and recognition of deferred gain. However, distribution costs rose 78.4% to \$1.7 million due to increase in freight and handling cost arising from a higher trading volume of non-ferrous metal. Consequently, net profit fell 48.2% to \$3.2 million compared to \$6.1 million previously.

Review for the 9 months ended 31 March 2009

For the nine months ended 31 March 2009, group revenue increased by 14.4% or \$29.4 million to \$234 million compared to the same period ended 31 March 2008. This was mainly attributed to the higher selling prices in the first three months of the financial year (July to September 2008).

Gross profit however fell 51.4% to \$9.2 million on the back of the precipitous plunge in the world's metal prices, particularly in October to December 2008. As a result, gross margin fell to 4% compared to 9.3% previously. Other operating income decreased 25.9% to \$12.7 million mainly due to more properties sold during the same period last year. Distribution costs increased by 68% or \$1.6 million to \$4 million but were partially offset by lower administrative expenses which decreased 18.1% or \$1.5 million to \$6.8 million. Other operating expenses rose to \$16.1 million and these included net foreign exchange losses of \$2.9 million, write-down in fair value of shares investments of \$7 million and impairment loss in inventories of \$2.4 million. Consequently, the group registered a loss after tax attributable to shareholders of \$6.6 million for 9MFY2009 as compared to \$19.3 million for the same period last year.

Balance Sheet Review

The Group's inventories decreased by 31.6% to \$48.2 million from \$70.5 million in 3QFY2009 as compared to last financial year ended 30 June 2008.

Shareholder's equity however decreased to \$54.4 million from \$68.3 million due to the net losses incurred in 9MFY2009 and dividend payments to shareholders. As a result, net asset value per share fell to 15.5 cents from 19.7 cents.

Cash Flow Statement Review

Net cash used in operating activities in 9MFY2009 was \$4.8 million compared to the net cash generated of \$3.7 million in the same period a year ago. This was primarily due to pretax losses incurred, decreases in trade and other payables as well as higher income tax paid for previous year's earnings.

The sale of one property for the period under review compared to the sale of four properties in the previous corresponding period caused the net cash provided by investing activities to decrease from \$22.6 million to \$3.3 million.

Net cash used in financing activities was \$9.3 million as compared to inflows of \$1.1 million previously. This was mainly attributed to payment of dividends to shareholders against a smaller increase in net bank borrowings.

Consequently, cash and cash balances as at 31 March 2009 was \$18.1 million compared to \$47.5 million as at 30 June 2008.

Going forward, the negative effects of the severe global downturn and the financial markets debacle will continue to create uncertainties in demand and supply and metal prices.

Against this backdrop, the Company is of the opinion that business conditions will remain challenging in 2009. Demand for metal is expected to remain relatively muted and be largely driven by specific economic activities. Steel prices and trading margins will remain under pressure due to intense competition and price volatility. The Company will continue to focus on optimising its core business and will strive to improve cost efficiencies while looking out for new opportunities.

Given the difficult market conditions, the full financial year's performance is not expected to improve significantly.
