In April 2008, the Company issued and allotted 69,421,050 warrants on the basis of one warrant for every five existing ordinary shares which carry the right to subscribe for one ordinary share of the Company with the exercise price of \$0.12 per ordinary share and with exercise dates up to 14 April 2011.

As at 30 September 2009, the total number of shares issued upon the exercise of warrants is 4,375,000 ordinary shares (30 September 2008: 1,041,000).

There were 65,046,050 and 68,380,050 outstanding warrants as at 30 September 2009 and 30 September 2008 respectively.

INCOME STATEMENT REVIEW

Revenue

The Group's revenue declined 62% or \$62.8 million to \$\$38.4 million in Q1 FY2010 from \$101.1 million for the corresponding period in the preceding financial year. The decline in revenue was caused by the lower demand and significantly lower selling prices for both ferrous and non-ferrous metals.

Profitability

Gross profit margin fell to 8.6% at \$3.3 million in Q1 FY2010 compared to 10.3% at \$10.4 million in Q1 FY2009. Lower gross profit was mainly due to lower revenue with lower selling price.

Other operating income rose 41.2% from \$2.5 million in Q1 FY2009 to \$3.6 million in Q1 FY2010, boosted by the sale of industrial property (No. 4 Pioneer Sector 1) and recognition of deferred gain from sale and lease back of properties. This is partially offset by decrease in rental income as a result of the completion in sale of industrial properties.

Distribution expenses of the Group decreased by 80.8% from \$1.5 million in Q1 FY2009 to \$0.3 million in Q1 FY2010, which was in line with lower shipments.

Administrative expenses declined 26.6% to S\$2.0 million due to lower staff cost and lower sales related expenses in Q1 FY2010.

Other operating expenses decreased 43.6% from \$3.9 million in Q1 FY2009 to \$2.2 million in Q1 FY2010. This decrease was due mainly to a reduction in net foreign exchange loss and impairment loss in inventories.

Finance costs in Q1 FY2010 also decreased by 58% or \$0.4 million to \$0.3 million (Q1 FY2009: \$0.7 million). This was due to a reduction in bank borrowings and trust receipts.

The Group has provided impairment loss of \$0.4 million for its Indonesia quoted warrants investment to reflect the prevailing uncertain economic conditions as well as the remaining short period to expiry of the warrants.

STATEMENT OF FINANCIAL POSITION REVIEW

The net assets and shareholders' fund of the Group was \$56.8 million as at 30 September 2009. The Group had reduced its inventory levels from \$49.3 million as at 30 June 2009 to \$43.2 million as at 30 September 2009. Trade receivables, trade payables and bank borrowings had also decreased.

The Group's gearing ratio further improved from 0.81 as at 30 June 2009 to 0.59 as at 30 September 2009.

STATEMENT OF CASH FLOW REVIEW

The Group's cash and cash equivalents was \$25.0 million as at 30 September 2009. Net cash from operating activities had improved significantly from a negative cash outflow of \$8.5 million in Q1 FY2009 to a positive cash inflow of \$7.0 million as a result of lower inventory levels and outstanding receivables.

The cash generated from operating activities were mainly used to reduce the Group's bank borrowings.

The business and trading environment remain difficult due to price volatility and weak demand for metal products. The low demand visibility in the metals market and competitive conditions in the local recycling market and steel market are likely to persist, going forward.

We will maintain our prudent measures in place to ensure good financial health to ride out this difficult period and to capitalize on any metal-related business expansion opportunities when it arises.
