STATEMENT OF COMPREHENSIVE INCOME REVIEW

Review for the three months ended 30 September 2012

Revenue increased by 28.1% to \$18.7 million mainly due to contributions from our new scaffolding subsidiary. Sales also saw mild improvement in scrap segment.

Gross profit improved by 16.7% to \$2.3 million mainly due to higher margin product mix.

Distribution and marketing expenses were down by 27.8% to \$0.1 million as a result of higher local sales compared to export sales.

Administrative expenses increased by 7.0% to \$1.8 million mainly due to increase in maintenance costs.

Other operating expenses decreased by 9.9% to \$1.5 million. This is mainly due to lower foreign exchange losses.

Finance cost increased by 21.4% to \$0.18 million mainly due to increase in bank borrowings compared to Q1FY12.

In line with higher profit, income tax expenses increased to \$ 0.08 million from \$ 0.02 million.

Hence, net profit increased from S\$0.31 million to S\$0.65 million in the current financial period.

STATEMENT OF FINANCIAL POSITION REVIEW

Group's total equity stood at \$86.3 million as at 30 September 2012.

Properties, plant and equipment decreased by \$1.6 million mainly due to depreciation charges and disposal of some fixed assets.

Trade and other receivables decreased by \$1.1 million mainly due to tighter credit controls.

Inventory level increased by \$1.6 million to \$39.9 million mainly due to purchases to replenish stock.

Bank borrowings decreased by \$7.4 million mainly due to repayment of loans and bills payables. Trade and other payables was higher by \$3.4 million mainly due to purchases of inventories.

STATEMENT OF CASH FLOW REVIEW

Net cash generated from operating activities for the period was \$3.9 million mainly due to increase in amount due to trade and other payables and improvement in trade receivables collection.

Net cash generated from investing activities of \$0.4 million was mainly due to the disposal of property, plant and equipment.

Net cash used in financing activities was \$7.3 million mainly due to repayment of bank borrowings.

The prolonged Eurozone crisis and significant global economic slowdown have a dampening effect on Singapore economy. We are cautious about business outlook in the next few months.

Singapore continues to experience manpower constraints largely due to the government's policy to restrict inflow of foreign labour. As a result, unit labour costs are expected to rise.

Overall operating environment we operate in will remain challenging. Moving forward, the group will remain vigilant and we will continue to explore ways of improving our productivity and efficiency.
